

# Negro Students Enroll For Fall Term Here

About 40 Negro students filled out pre-enrollment papers Wednesday night to attend junior and senior high school in Mansfield this fall.

Accompanied by their parents, the students gathered in the high school cafeteria after arriving in a group and were given instructions and information on courses offered here by Counselor R. L. Anderson and Superintendent Willie Pigg.

Also present were leaders of the Negro community, Mansfield School Board President J. L. Boren, board member Buzz Perry, and members of the faculty.

The orderly meeting was in contrast to a similar effort to enroll in 1956 when local opposition was encountered.

Number of Negro students entering school here next school year will include seven 7th graders, 11 8th graders, five freshmen, eight sophomores, five juniors and nine

seniors. About 10 others may be enrolled later.

Schedules for students will
