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ties and programs sponsored by or affiliated with the schools of the school system."

The local board adopted the plan of desegregation on January 26, 1965 and filed it with the Commissioner of Education of the U. S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare in Washington. The plan was filed under threat of loss of federal aid for non-compliance.

The board has been advised of requirements of the Civil Rights Act including periodic reviews by the staff of the Texas Education Agency to determine that practices are in conformity with terms of the Act, regulations of the U.S. Education Commissioner and the school district's plan of desegregation.

Other provisions call for administration of federally assisted programs on a non-discriminatory basis and allow for receiving and evaluating any complaints that might come from any citizens.
